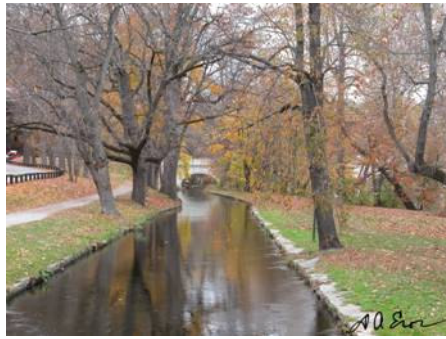


Park Tours

Brandywine Park, nestled in the heart of Wilmington, stretches along one mile of the serpentine Brandywine Creek. Picnic sites are available, so bring lunch or dinner and make it a memorable trip! Each 90-minute tour begins and ends in the parking lot under I-95 just upstream from the Jasper Crane Rose Garden. Tours are limited to 25 participants.
